# TAKE ACTION

## TO END HUMAN TRAFFICKING

### BE A CONSCIOUS CONSUMER

- Take the Slavery Footprint survey ([slaveryfootprint.org](http://slaveryfootprint.org))
- Use KnowTheChain to review supply chains ([knowthechain.org](http://knowthechain.org))
- Choose products free from forced labor; look for Fair Trade products
- Check the U.S. Department of Labor's forced labor goods list
- Ask brands about sourcing and labor practices

### RAISE AWARENESS

- Share information on recognizing and reporting trafficking
- Host a presentation or discussion in your community by visiting ([www.alliancetoendhumantrafficking.org/speaker-request](http://www.alliancetoendhumantrafficking.org/speaker-request))
- Write to local leaders or submit a letter to the editor
- Use and share resources from the Alliance to End Human Trafficking's social media and website

### SUPPORT SURVIVORS

- Organize a backpack or donation drive for local partners
- Support organizations providing direct services
- Contribute gift cards or essential items for survivors
- Support survivor-led businesses or initiatives

### ADVOCATE FOR CHANGE

- Contact elected officials to support anti-trafficking legislation, and sign up for the Alliance to End Human Trafficking's Action Alerts to take action.
- Encourage companies to improve supply chain accountability
- Promote policies that protect workers and prevent exploitation
- Write to companies urging transparency and ethical sourcing

### PRAY AND REFLECT

- Include prayer intentions for victims and survivors in your community
- Observe National Human Trafficking Awareness Month and February 8 (Feast of St. Josephine Bakhita)
- Mark key awareness days with prayer or reflection
- Organize or participate in a Mass or prayer service focused on human trafficking and human dignity
